**For FY 2010-2011, no change to fees except those based on the contract hourly rate. The fees shown below were approved by the Board of Supervisors on June 2, 2009.**

### VENTURA COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DIVISION SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS PERMITS AND SERVICES

Type of Permit/Service	Fee
1. The fee for individual sewage disposal system plan checking and evaluation by the Environmental Health Division shall be as follows:  a. Each individual sewage disposal system consisting of a septic tank and either leach lines, leaching beds, seepage pits, or a combination thereof, other than those described in sub-section (b).	\$943.00 plus \$27.00 for each 250 gallons of septic tank capacity or part thereof in excess of 1,500 gallons.
b. Individual sewage disposal system consisting of a septic tank and either leach lines, leaching beds, seepage pits, or combination thereof in subdivisions of 3 or more contiguous lots with substantially identical soil and topographic conditions.	\$943.00 for each system on the first 3 lots plus \$55.00 for each system on each lot in excess of 3 lots.
c. Each individual sewage disposal system consisting of a septic tank and either a mound system, sub-surface sand filtration system, or other system, if any, expressly permitted by Ventura County Ordinance, other than those described in sub-sections (a) or (b).	\$1,779.00
d. Each marine or recreational dump station.	\$783.00

<p>2. The fee for evaluating and processing by the Environmental Health Division of applications for certification of existing individual sewage disposal systems other than those described in Section 3 or Section 4 shall be:</p>	<p>\$859.00</p>
<p>3. The fee for evaluating and processing by the Environmental Health Division of applications for certification of existing individual sewage disposal systems where the only issue is whether the system meets setback requirements, shall be:</p>	<p>\$304.00</p>
<p>4. The fee for evaluating and processing by the Environmental Health Division of applications for certification of existing individual sewage disposal systems where the only issue is whether the system meets setback requirements and an accurate plot plan of said system is on file with the Environmental Health Division, shall be:</p>	<p>\$109.00</p>
<p>5. The fee for evaluating and processing by the Environmental Health Division of applications for exceptions to Code requirements pursuant to Ventura County Building Code Section UPC Appendix K-1(f) shall be:</p>	<p>\$411.00 for individual system covered by the application.</p>
<p>6. The fee for evaluating and processing by the Environmental Health Division of applications for permits to install holding tanks for non-hazardous industrial wastes shall be:</p>	<p>\$986.00</p>

<p>7. The fee for inspection by the Environmental Health Division of the installation of individual sewage disposal systems consisting of a septic tank and either leach lines, leaching beds, seepage pits, or a combination thereof shall be:</p>	<p>\$420.00</p>
<p>8. The fee for inspection by the Environmental Health Division of the installation of individual sewage disposal systems consisting of a septic tank and either a mound system, sub-surface sand filtration system, or other system, if any, expressly permitted by Ventura County Ordinance, other than those described in section 6, shall be:</p>	<p>\$497.00</p>
<p>9. The fee for inspection by the Environmental Health Division of repair or modification work to existing individual sewage disposal systems shall be:</p>	<p>\$228.00</p>
<p>10. The fee for reinspection by the Environmental Health Division of the installation, repair, or modification of individual sewage disposal systems described in Sections 6, 7, and 8, when assessed pursuant to Section 108.8 of the Uniform Building Code as incorporated by reference in the Ventura County Building Code, shall be an amount equal to the contract hourly rate for an Environmental Health Specialist IV in effect when the fee is assessed, multiplied by the number of person-hours, rounded up to the nearest one-half hour actually expended by County personnel in performing such reinspection.</p>	<p><b>The contract hourly rate for an EHS IV for FY 2010-2011 is \$124.00.</b></p> <p><b>This is effective 8/15/10.</b></p>

11. The fee for evaluating alternative technology systems by the Environmental Health Division for compliance with the County Building Code Ordinance Appendix Chapter K, Section K1 et. Seq., shall be an initial deposit amount based on a minimum 20 hours charged at the contract hourly rate established by the Board for an Environmental Health Specialist IV.

The applicant will be billed for any subsequent time that exceeds the minimum review time, in addition to any costs incurred through a third party review by a consulting engineer if required by the Environmental Health Division.

**The contract hourly rate for an EHS IV for FY 2010-2011 is \$124.00.**
