

# E R R A T A

Subsequent to printing the Simi Valley Landfill and Recycling Center Expansion Project Final EIR, it was discovered that the wording for **Mitigation Measure BIO-6** had not been corrected to reflect the final version. The corrected wording for **BIO-6** is as follows:

**BIO-6:** To ensure the continued availability of the Alamos Canyon Wildlife Corridor (“the Corridor”) for the benefit of native plants and wildlife, the permittee shall enhance and manage habitat in and adjacent to the Alamos Canyon wildlife corridor, including the riparian zone and adjacent upland habitats. The area to be preserved shall include the Alamos Canyon Corridor within the following boundaries: the SR-118 freeway on the south end, the latitude of the northernmost portion of the buffer area associated with the proposed landfill expansion on the north end, the project CUP boundary on the east side, and the rim of Alamos Canyon on the west side. In order to ensure that the Corridor enhancements remain in perpetuity, a biological restrictive covenant shall be recorded with the County of Ventura that encompasses the Corridor area to be enhanced/preserved. Enhancement shall be as described in Mitigation Measure BIO-7.

The mitigation measure appears in the following locations and the text in these locations should be replaced by the text above.
