### ATTACHMENT A

#### Consumer Notification Information

California Health and Safety Code Section 4028 requires consumer notification whenever any primary drinking water standard is not complied with, or when a monitoring requirement is not performed.

Sample notification format(s) are attached. Notification to all consumers should be completed by inclusion with the first set of water bills issued after date of this notice, or within three months, whichever is sooner. This includes the obligation to notify each resident of an apartment, condominium, mobile home complex or other multiple dwelling unit, each employee of any business, and teachers, parents and students of any school on the system. Send a copy of the notification to the Environmental Health Division.

If notification is being done for a maximum contaminant level violation, then it must also be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the area on three consecutive days, within fourteen days of date of this notice. A copy of the notice shall also be furnished to the radio and television stations serving the area served by the system.
