Important Notice

Regarding Your Annual Invoice

A new law recently went into effect that will affect your annual Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) consolidated invoice that you pay to Ventura County Environmental Health Division. Assembly Bill 2286 was signed by the Governor last year and requires the implementation of a new electronic data reporting system.

The law requires all regulated businesses to file the Unified Program information electronically by January 1, 2013. This information is now filed by paper forms and includes information regarding hazardous material chemical inventories, underground and aboveground storage tanks, and hazardous waste generation.



To pay for the cost of implementing this electronic reporting system statewide, the legislature mandated CUPAs collect a temporary additional State Surcharge of \$25 per year for three years. Your invoice now includes an additional line item labeled "Electronic Reporting Surcharge".
