

FILM PERMIT AMENDMENT

After a Film Permit has been issued, minor aspects of the original permit may be amended provided:

1. No new permits are required for the changes, (e.g. adding pyrotechnics that requires a new permit from the Fire Prevention District or adding a road shoot which necessitates an encroachment permit).
2. The change does not trigger the need for waivers from the neighbors (e.g. extending the prep, filming or strike phases past 10:00pm or before 7:00am).
3. A new location is not being included (e.g. a separate property and landowner is involved).

Examples of minor amendments include:

1. Extending the number of filming days
2. Rearranging the shooting schedule so that the total number of days does not change, but the sequence of locations used is rearranged.
3. Shifting the production schedule (e.g. moving the entire project back one week).
4. The order of scenes is altered so that clearances from various County departments must be rescheduled.
5. The property to be used is the same, but the location where shooting will occur will be moved.
6. Other circumstances that the film permit coordinator concludes would be acceptable prior to a formal application being submitted.

To apply for an Amendment:

1. Go to the Ventura County Planning Departments website at, www.ventura.org/planning/permits/film , and print out the amendment form in the film permit section of website.
2. Fill in the required areas stating what part of the permit is being amended and sign the form.
3. Fax the amendment to (805) 477-7168 prior to filming. The film permit coordinator will issue you an amendment via email when approved.
